NCTI – Bay Area (Livermore) Paramedic Program Outcomes

Accredited Paramedic Programs track and report outcome measures annually to the Committee on Accreditation for the Emergency Medical Services Professions.

For 2017, the success rate for the National Registry of EMT Paramedic Cognitive exam was **84.2%**.

For 2017, the success rate for positive placement rate for graduates was **82.4%**. Positive placement is defined by the CoAEMSP as 'Employed full or part-time in a related field and/or continuing his/her education and/or serving in the military'. Positive placement is measured at completion of the program.

For 2017, the success rate for retention rate was **76.3%**.

The most recent 3 year success rate for the National Registry of EMT Paramedic Cognitive exam is **94%**.

The most recent 3 year success rate for the National Registry of EMT Paramedic Practical exam is **96%**.

The most recent 3 year positive placement rate for graduates is **71%**. Positive placement is defined by the CoAEMSP as 'Employed full or part-time in a related field and/or continuing his/her education and/or serving in the military'. Positive placement is measured at completion of the program.

The most recent 3 year retention rate is **75%**.
