Ongoing Neonatal Base Training (See Clinical Education Requirements) Cardiac Assist Training – Base Specific with annual documentation Clinical Rounds and Required Reading Completed Monthly	
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Clinical Training Lab Notes:

1. Two skills labs will be conducted at each base during the year, one adult and one pediatric/neonatal/OB.
2. Attendance at the crewmember's 'home' base CTL session is mandatory (one day per session/ twice a year). If crew member is unable to attend 'home' base CTL's, attendance at an alternate base CTL must be approved by CBM's of base(s) involved.
3. Skills lab sessions will each be four hours in duration.
4. In-hospital Clinical Rotations may be assigned in addition to the skills labs to meet specific learning and/or skills proficiency needs.

Safety/Operational/ Recurrent Training Notes:

1. Topics are to be completed based upon the above training calendar.
2. Monthly Emergency Procedure Drills will be provided by the Aviation Department and tracked by the Base Safety Rep.
3. Annual NVG recurrent training based upon individual training cycle and tracked by the lead pilots, to include Form 202.
4. There may be additional local EMS/base requirements. It is the responsibility of each crewmember to track these base-specific items.

Monthly Training Compliance Notes:

1. Monthly airway case studies are included in mandatory training tracked via Cornerstone
 - Airway case studies are distributed monthly via email on the 1st of the month
 - Airway case studies include a proficiency review and must be audited by Clinical Base Manager or designee
 - Airway case studies include ventilator management strategy to be depicted by crew in exercise completion
 - Completed case studies will be submitted to the Clinical Base Manager prior to base meetings and reviewed at monthly base meetings
2. All clinical crewmembers must complete a minimum of four adult, four pediatric and four neonatal intubations per quarter.
 - Intubation requirements may be met by field intubations, in the OR, in an approved animal or cadaver lab, on manikins, or on Sim-Man/Sim-Baby in alignment with Airway Drill schedule.
 - Intubations performed during the monthly airway case study may be used to satisfy the quarterly requirements.
 - All intubations (simulator AND live) must be entered into Cornerstone for tracking
3. Monthly compliance for Airway case study, assigned proficiency, Cornerstone, mandatory reading, Clinical Rounds, documented intubations will be tracked by the Clinical Manager.
4. Biannual CTL attendance will be tracked by the Clinical Base Manager.
