Paramedic Program Outcomes

Accredited Paramedic Programs track and report outcome measures annually to the Committee on Accreditation for the Emergency Medical Services Professions.

For **2020**, the success rate for the National Registry of EMT Paramedic Cognitive exam was 92.3%.

For **2020**, the success rate for positive placement rate for graduates was 73.2%. Positive placement is defined by the CoAEMSP as 'Employed full or part-time in a related field and/or continuing his/her education and/or serving in the military'. Positive placement is measured at completion of the program.

For **2020**, the success rate for retention rate was 70.3%

For **2019**, the success rate for the National Registry of EMT Paramedic Cognitive exam was 94.6%.

For **2019**, the success rate for positive placement rate for graduates was 77.2%. Positive placement is defined by the CoAEMSP as 'Employed full or part-time in a related field and/or continuing his/her education and/or serving in the military'. Positive placement is measured at completion of the program.

For **2019**, the success rate for retention rate was *58.8%
